



Stockton Civic Theatre SCT JR. Scholarship

Each summer, Stockton Civic Theatre (SCT) hosts a five-week summer youth camp. The camp is offered in two divisions: SCT Jr. Stage for youth interested in acting, singing, and dancing; and SCT Jr. Crew for youth interested in stagecraft design, and construction of sets, props, and costumes. Each division is hosted simultaneously and culminates in performing a full-scale musical in front of an audience for six performances. SCT Jr. Summer Camp provides a challenging, innovative, high-quality arts education to its students.

SCT Jr. Children's Theatre Summer Program is happy to announce its 2020 **SCT Jr. Scholarship Program**. The scholarship will award ten (10) \$200 scholarships to students who are in financial need. Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Applicants must be eligible to enroll in the 2020 SCT Jr. Children's Theatre Summer Program. Students must be between the ages of 8 years old as of Monday, June 22nd, 2020, and no older than 17 years old as of Thursday, July 23rd, 2020.
- Scholarship funds will be applied to the student's SCT Jr Children's Theatre Summer Program tuition, and not the student. The remaining balance of the tuition must be paid on registration day, April 19, 2020.
- Applications must be received by the SCT no later than **Friday, March 20th, 2020**. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Top applicants may be required to attend an on-site interview process the week of March 30, 2020.
